June M. Johnson graduated in 1937 from Mankato State Teachers College and taught elementary school in rural southern Minnesota. June was a second-generation alumna and her children are third-generation alumni of the University. June's daughter Patricia R. Johnson ('71) established this scholarship in her mother's memory.

Eligibility Criteria

1. Enrolled as a student in the College of Social and Behavioral Sciences (CSBS) at Minnesota State University Mankato with at least one semester remaining in which to complete a study abroad experience;
2. Admitted into a CSBS-sponsored study abroad program with CSBS faculty;
3. The study abroad experience should take place during the year for which the scholarship is awarded; and
4. Have a 3.0 GPA or higher.
5. Preference given to full-time students

Application

1. Fill out the application form and attach the indicated supplemental information.
2. Send application form and attachments to the address indicated on the application form.

Recipient Requirements

1. Using a given series of questions and writing prompts, recipients will maintain a Study Abroad Journal before, during, and after their study abroad experiences.
2. Within 3 weeks of returning from the study abroad experience, recipients will submit the journal to the CSBS Dean's office, AH 111.
3. Attend the College of Social and Behavioral Sciences Scholarship Dinner in fall.

- 2) A current Minnesota State Mankato transcript (unofficial copy accepted);
- 3) A 1-2 page narrative describing the applicant's leadership abilities and explaining her/his goals for pursuing a study abroad experience; and
- 4) A letter of recommendation from a current teacher or career counselor that addresses the applicant's academic achievements and abilities. The letter should include the recommender's name, title, and relationship to the applicant.
