I. REQUIREMENTS

These scholarships were established to encourage enrollment in the Minnesota State University, Mankato (MSU) Ethnic Studies curriculum beyond the introductory level. The scholarship provides a tuition credit on your fee statement for the academic year. Applicants must have taken the Ethnic Studies course American Racial Minorities or Introduction to Ethnic Studies. The applicant will agree to have completed an additional six Ethnic Studies credits at the completion of the award year. Available funds will be distributed in two equal installments at the beginning of each semester through Financial Aid and will show up as a credit on your fee statement. Application forms are available in the Ethnic Studies office, 109 Morris Hall. Application deadline is March 16, 2007. **You must include an unofficial transcript.**

II. AWARD TYPE/CRITERIA

A. We will recognize three outstanding Ethnic Studies students (major, minor or graduate) with an award of at least \$200 each. The **Academic Excellence Scholarship** will go to a student with the highest GPA. The **Achievement Scholarship** will go to a student who has overcome great difficulties or challenges in maintaining a high GPA. The **Global Ethnic Diversity Scholarship** will go to a student who is an Ethnic Studies major with a GPA of 3.0 or higher and has brought his/her home country culture to our campus.
