Eligibility Criteria

1. Enrolled as a full-time student in the College of Social and Behavioral Sciences (CSBS) at Minnesota State University Mankato with at least one semester remaining in which to complete a study abroad experience. The college considers full-time enrollment to be 12 credits during the academic year and 6 credits during summer session.
2. Admitted into a CSBS-sponsored study abroad program with CSBS faculty member leading.
3. The study abroad experience should take place during the year for which the scholarship is awarded.
4. Have a 3.0 GPA or higher.

Recipient Requirements

1. Using a given series of questions and writing prompts, recipients will maintain a Study Abroad Journal before, during, and after their study abroad experiences.
2. Within 3 weeks of returning from the study abroad experience, recipients will submit the journal to the CSBS Dean's office, AH 111.
3. Attend the College of Social and Behavioral Sciences Scholarship Dinner in fall 2019.
